## Enrollment: Frequently Asked Questions

- 1. Is there a charge for students to attend DVA?** DVA is a public charter school and as such, there is no charge for admission.
- 2. What grades are offered at Desert View Academy (DVA)?** At DVA, we provide instruction for students in kindergarten through fifth grade.
- 3. How many classes are available at each grade?** During the 2016-2017 school year, we have six classes in kindergarten, first and second grades, four classes in third and fourth grades, and three classes in fifth grade.
- 4. How many students are in each class?** We cap our class sizes at 26 students per class. When enrollment exceeds 26 students per class, students are placed on a waiting list.
- 5. How does busing work at DVA?** DVA offers limited busing. Once busing capacity is reached, students are placed on a waiting list for services. We find that most of our families either drive their own children to school or they participate in a carpool, with other parents.
- 6. Are family members given preferential treatment, with regard to enrollment?** Yes. Families that have students already enrolled with DVA are given the first spaces available in each grade level. Should a family member enroll in a grade that has a waiting list, that child will be placed ahead of those, already on the list, that do not have family members enrolled.
